

## Purebred Sire and Dam of the Year Award Program Rules

The society would like to recognize the contributions of the purebred lineage through the performance accomplishments of pure and part bred in the Performance Awards Program.

PA programs not only recognize the talents and efforts of Cleveland Bays out there performing but can also serve as an aide to both breeders and buyers to discover which CB lines are active, successful and excel in different disciplines. How it works: Purebred sires and dams will earn points throughout the PA year not only for themselves, but each of their progeny enrolled in the PA program. The purebred sire or dam need not be enrolled in the PA program to be considered and accumulate points for this award. Points will count for EACH progeny enrolled in the program. For partbred competitors, the closest purebred ancestor is given credit. Example: For a 1/8th bred CB, the great grand parent will be credited.

Points and Rules will be allocated as follows:

- 2 points for returning a PA book with non-qualifying scores
- 4 points for returning a PA book with qualifying scores but not placing in a division
- 6 points for year end individual division Third place
- 8 points for year end individual division Reserve Champion
- 10 points for year end individual division Champion
- 5 points for a Pony Club completed entry
- 5 points for a Field Hunter completed entry
- 5 points for Lifetime Achievement Award completed program
- 4 points for a horse that has returned a PA book and has an offspring in the program that has returned a PA book.

Deceased sires and dams are eligible as their progeny is part of their legacy. Sire or Dam need not be licensed by any organization. Sire and dam must be registered in accordance with CBHSNA policy. Points are allocated to the horse (not the owner). No prize is awarded. At this time this is an award and accolade in name and title only to demonstrate the Cleveland Bay is a performance breed. Annual winners will be kept on record. Past and present owners of winners will be encouraged to submit material for a feature spread/article in the *BayWatch* and year end printed issue of The Chronicle of the Cleveland Bay Horse in North America. In cases of a tie, the winner will be determined by the number of progeny that return a log book with eligible scores to the Administrator.
