

## 2023 CLEVELAND BAY HUNTER HORSE SHOW

Pleasant Prospect Farm • 4389 Jennings Chapel Road • Brookville, Maryland

Sunday, May 21, 2023 at 10:00 AM

**This show enthusiastically promotes, but is not part of, the Mid-Atlantic Cleveland Bay Show Series. All Cleveland Bays are welcome, and it is the organizers' hope that owners and trainers will use it to prepare for the all-important Upperville show in June.**

- All classes are open to purebred and partbred Cleveland Bays.
  - In support of the future of the breed, the show organizers encourage registration with the Cleveland Bay Horse Society of the UK (CBHS).
  - Purebreds must demonstrate that they are either registered with the CBHS Stud Book, or are eligible for entry in the Stud Book.
  - All others will show as partbreds (Cleveland Bay pedigree must be reasonably established).
- There will be up to six ribbons per class.
- Division Champion and Reserve will be recognized for the Novice and Hunter Divisions.
- A tie for Division Champion or Reserve will be determined by placement in the over fences classes.
- Show Champion and Reserve will be presented to the two highest-scoring Cleveland Bay Horses (purebred or partbred, registered or unregistered) across all classes and division championships, except as noted in class list.
- A tie for either the Show Champion or Reserve will be determined by placement in the Handy Hunter class.
- The Show Champion will be recognized on the Pleasant Prospect Farm Cleveland Bay High Point perpetual trophy.
- High-Point rosettes will be presented for the highest-scoring CBHS-registered purebred and highest-scoring CBHS-registered partbred Cleveland Bay Horse.
- There will be a warm-up before Classes 4 and 9, and horses may do non-judged classes or schooling rounds.
- To support Cleveland Bay owners and trainers who have other horses that may need show experience, non-Cleveland Bay horses may exhibit unjudged in classes or schooling rounds.
- All entries must include a record of a negative EIA (Coggins) dated within one year of the show date.
- Competitors and attendees are warmly invited to visit the hospitality tent for light refreshments throughout the show.

1. **Purebred Cleveland Bay In Hand** - Shown in hand at walk & trot. Bridles mandatory on horses 2 years and older.
2. **Partbred Cleveland Bay In Hand** – Shown in hand at walk & trot. Bridles mandatory on horses 2 years and older.
3. **Cleveland Bay Get-of-Sire or Produce-of-Dam** – Each entry is comprised of two offspring sharing either the same dam or the same sire, shown in hand at walk & trot. Bridles mandatory on horses 2 years and older. One class entry covers both offspring. This class does not count toward total show points.
4. **Cleveland Bay Dressage Suitability** – Judged at walk, trot & canter. Extension & collection may be requested. Horses need not be trained extensively in dressage to exhibit in this class.

Open to horses in their 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years of showing under tack, or riders not jumping higher than 2' in any competition. Horses competing in the Novice Hunter Division may compete in the Hunter Division, but are not eligible for Champion or Reserve placings in that division, and class placings in the Hunter Division will not count toward total show points.

5. **Cleveland Bay Novice Hunter Walk/Trot Under Saddle** – Shown at walk & trot on both reins.
6. **Cleveland Bay Novice Hunter Under Saddle** – Shown at walk, trot & canter on both reins.
7. **Cleveland Bay Novice Hunter Over Fences** – Shown over a course of 6-8 fences at 2'. Simple changes allowed.
8. **Cleveland Bay Novice Hunter Over Fences** - Same as Class 7, different course.

9. **Cleveland Bay Hunter Under Saddle** – Shown at walk, trot & canter on both reins.
10. **Cleveland Bay Hunter Hack** – Shown at walk, trot & canter on both reins, and jump two fences at 2'6". May be asked to show at the hand-gallop, at the discretion of the judge.
11. **Cleveland Bay Hunter Over Fences** – Shown over a course of 8 fences at 2'6". Judged on performance, soundness, suitability & manners.
12. **Cleveland Bay Hunter Over Fences** – Same as Class 11, different course.

13. **Cleveland Bay Handy Hunter** – Shown over a course that includes elements to show rideability and handiness, e.g., roll back, trot fences, option lines, combination fences.
